-  Proposed Wildflower Meadow Mixture. Emorsgate (or similar) EM1 Basic General Purpose Meadow Mixture, slightly modified to include a larger percentage of robust tussock grass.
-  Proposed Tussock Grass Mix to play space peripheries. Emorsgate (or similar) EG10 Tussock Grass Mix.
-  Proposed Seating. Broxap (or similar), Treated SW Hatton 4 slat seat. Ref: BX17 4055
-  Proposed timber sleeper raised beds for community growing hub. 1200 x 1200 x 600mm high
